

## Sgt. James Green's Gallantry Awards

Sergeant Green served with the Oxfordshire and Buckinghamshire Light Infantry. His family have passed his medals to the Soldiers of Oxfordshire Museum at Woodstock for safe keeping. With the medals were two Mention in Dispatches certificates and a presentation certificate from the village of Benson, where James lived. The certificate is shown on the next page.

by the **P**arishioners of **B**enson,  
in recognition of his bravery on **M**arch 7<sup>th</sup>. 1918 in  
**M**esopotamia during the **G**reat **W**ar.  
**W**HILE on patrol in command of six men he  
captured 25 **T**urks and two machine guns, for  
which he was awarded the **M**ilitary **M**edal.  
**H**E was also mentioned in dispatches on  
**N**ov. 2<sup>nd</sup>. 1917, and on **A**pril 15<sup>th</sup>. 1918.
