

ARTHUR JAMES MUMFORD OF BENSON

FROM BENSON WARM MEMORIAL & GRAVES BOOK: He was enrolled in the Royal Berks regiment but was recorded as being a Private in the Dorset Reg. when he was killed in action, near Passchendaele 27 Feb 1918. His parents were Henry and Sarah Mumford of **Benson**.
