

COLLEGE FARM HOUSE BY JOHN ALDRIDGE

On the other side of High Street, is **College Farm House**, 17th Century part roughcast ragstone and brick construction with clay tile roof. There are 18th and 19th Century additions with store and old stables to the east. On the Chapel Lane elevation is a fine 17th Century chimney stack with rectangular base, two diamond shafts and offset heads. The front garden is enclosed by ragstone and brick dwarf wall and 18th Century wrought iron railings to the west. There was a very old Acacia tree near the High Street, lying at an acute angle but still flourishing after possibly 200 years. Although sadly now felled and carted away, I noticed in July 1995 that new saplings are sprouting from the roots.
